Attainment: above the grade expectation. Effort: consistent.

Lila reads fluently and chooses books without being steered. Written work is organised. She is beginning to hold an argument across a paragraph rather than a list of sentences. Spelling of subject words is reliable. Speaking in discussion is still quiet; she has good points and does not always put them in.

Mathematics

Attainment: at the grade expectation. Effort: good.

Number work is sound. She is slower when a problem has more than one step, and she checks when reminded. Fractions of amounts are in place. Time on a clock face still needs practice. She asks for help early, which is useful.

Natural Sciences

Attainment: above the grade expectation. Effort: high.

She is curious in practical work and writes a fair method. Her term project on water use was clear and finished on time. She links what she sees to the idea, not only to the worksheet line.

Afrikaans

Attainment: at the grade expectation. Effort: steady.

Listening is stronger than writing. She joins in oral work. Written sentences are short and correct more often than they are ambitious. Reading aloud is careful.
